Important points to be noted:

- (1) The process of admission for the academic session 2022-23 of Jhargram Raj College will be done strictly on online merit-based system as per the Govt. Orders issued by the Higher Education Department, Govt of West Bengal and Vidyasagar University notifications from time to time.
- (2) As per rules, candidates belonging to SC/ST category must secure at least 75% of the marks obtained by the last General category candidate to be eligible for admission.
- (3) As per rules, candidates belonging to OBC(A) /OBC(B) must secure at least 90% of the marks obtained by the last General category candidate to be eligible for admission.
- (4) As per rules, in case of absence of suitable candidates in reserved seats, SC seats may be filled up with ST candidates and vice versa. Similarly, OBC-A seats may be filled up with OBC-B candidates and vice versa.
- (5) The admission schedule may be subject to change under unavoidable circumstances.
