## M. A. in Bengali, M. Sc. in Chemistry and M. Sc. in Zoology

At Jhargram Raj College, under Vidyasagar University for the academic session 2023-2024

The candidates will fill in the Application Form only through **online portal**. The applicants will have to fill in the form with the personal details, academic details and upload the scanned copies of all the required documents at the time of application. As per order of the Govt. of West Bengal (Ref No. 439 - Edn(CS)/lOM-95/14, Dated: 13th July 2023), the application fee has been completely waived off.

The eligible applicants are required to fill in the forms for admission to the aforesaid courses with their Percentage (%) of Marks (Part-I, II & III) obtained in UG (Honours) course in annual system. In case of semester system, applicants must fill equivalent percentage of marks corresponding to their CGPA obtained as per the rule fixed by their home institution. Candidates must upload the relevant documents showing official conversion rule (upload reverse side of the marksheet if conversion rule for CGPA to equivalent percentage is mentioned. Otherwise, candidates must upload the official conversion rule for the same along with their marksheet).

All applicants have to appear for an ADMISSION TEST on 21.09.2023 in OFFLINE mode at Jhargram Raj College center. The ADMIT CARD can be downloaded along with filled up online application form as soon as the application process is completed. The syllabus of the ADMISSION TEST is based on Honours Undergraduate level (UG) syllabus. Questions for the ADMISSION TEST will be of MCQ (Multiple Choice Questions) type. The evaluation process will be as per the following format-

- i) For each correct answer: (+4)
- ii) For each wrong answer: (-1)

Candidates are **not required to submit** any print-out/hardcopy of the filled up online application form.

# Eligibility Criteria:

**M. A. in Bengali:** 45% marks in Honours (for General candidates) and 40% marks in Honours (for SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B/DAP candidates).

**M. Sc. in Chemistry & Zoology:** 50% marks in Honours (for General candidates) and 45% marks in Honours (for SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B/DAP candidates).

### GENERAL DIRECTION TO THE APPLICANTS FOR ONLINE ADMISSION

- 1. The online admission process for the academic session 2023-24 of Jhargram Raj College will be done strictly based on merit. The merit list will be prepared based on the marks obtained in the qualifying examinations (UG) and ADMISSION TEST taking 50% weightage from each category.
- 2. Each applicant must use his/her **own e-mail id** and **personal mobile number** at the time of online application.
- 3. Honours candidates for the current session (students passed out in the year 2023) and the immediately preceding session (students passed out in the year 2022) are eligible to apply and will be considered equally.
- 4. 80% of the total seats in each subject will be considered for the students of Vidyasagar University and the remaining 20% will be for Open Competition.
- 5. The merit list will be prepared in the following manner: -

50% weightage of the marks obtained in UG Examination + 50% weightage of the marks obtained in ADMISSION TEST (Candidate who will score negative as total will be considered to be zero mark).

[UG (Hons.) final percentage of marks (Part-I, Part-II and Part-III taking together) in case of annual system.

OR

UG (Hons) equivalent percentage of marks converted from CGPA, in case of semester (CBCS) system.]

In case of a tie, marks/percentage obtained in UG examination will be considered for ranking. In case of further tie, total marks/percentage of marks of immediately preceding examination (H. S. or equivalent) will be considered for ranking. In case of further tie, the total marks/percentage of marks obtained in the General papers of the B. A. / B. Sc. examination will be considered for ranking.

- 6. Quota for the SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B/PWD will be considered as per Government order 906 Edn/Estt dated 18/09/1997. A fraction of 0.5 or more will be rounded to the next whole number.
- 7. Quota for the General Category and EWS in general category will be considered as per Government order.
- 8. In case of the non-availability of students of SC category, the seats reserved for SC may be converted to the ST category, and vice versa (vide Item No. (iii) of the Vidyasagar University circular with Ref. No.: VU/PG/186/17, dt. 29.05.2017 from the Secretary, Faculty Council for PG Studies).
- 9. In case of the non-availability of candidates of the OBC-A category, the seats for OBC-A may be converted to the OBC-B category and vice versa (vide Item No. (iv) of the Vidyasagar University circular with Ref. No.: VU/PG/186/17, dt. 29.05.2017 from the Secretary, Faculty Council for PG Studies).

- 10. 5% of each category will be reserved for Differently Abled Person (DAP). Merit list will be prepared on the percentage of DAP. In case of the non-availability of candidates belonging to the Differently Abled Person (DAP) category, the seats reserved for the said category will be converted to the General category (vide Item No. (v) of the Vidyasagar University circular with Ref. No.: VU/PG/186/17, dt. 29.05.2017 from the Secretary, Faculty Council for PG Studies).
- 11. Online provisional admission will be done based on the merit list and category wise availability of seats published through the PG admission portal of our college.
- 12. Counselling for admission to these courses will be held first for the 80% category followed by counselling of the 20% category.

# NB: Category-wise Distribution of Seats (including EWS) for the current year (2023-24) will be notified as soon as the Seat Distribution related order is received from Vidyasagar University.

#### This 80% and 20% may be relaxed due to non-availability of applicants in either category.

- 13. The students of Vidyasagar University are eligible to apply for both 80% and 20% category seats whereas the students of other universities and autonomous colleges are eligible to fill up the application forms for admission to the Post-Graduate courses under 20% category only.
- 14. SC/ST candidates must have 75% of the marks obtained by the last candidate of the General category as qualifying marks. OBC-A/OBC-B candidates must have 90% of the marks obtained by the last candidate of the General category as qualifying marks. Candidates with lower marks will not be considered for admission even if the seats remain vacant in respective categories. (As per Memo No. 66-Edn(U)/1U-89/13 dated 16.01.2014 of the Higher Education Department, Government of West Bengal).
- 15. If any applicant enlisted in any merit list does not take admission and make the e-payment within the scheduled time span, no further chance of admission can be given to him/her.
- 16. All the provisionally admitted candidates are required to produce all the originals of uploaded Certificates, Mark Sheets and testimonials at the time of physical verification of documents.

- 17. The verification of documents of candidates, qualified for both the 80% and 20% categories will be held in the respective Departments from 12.00 Noon onwards on the specified dates, to be notified in due course of time.
- 18. All admissions done on online system are strictly provisional.
- 19. Admission will be cancelled out- rightly if the information stated in the application forms are not found in conformity with the documents submitted at the time of verification or any fake document is produced.
- 20. If at any stage, it is found that a candidate has concealed, suppressed or distorted any information/fact in the application form, his/her admission shall be summarily cancelled.
